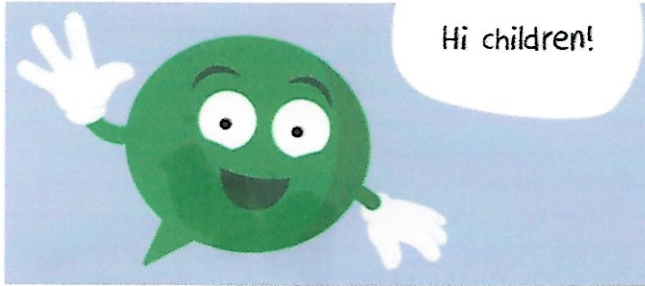


Internet Safety for 6-10 year olds

Top 10 ways you can stay safe on line

Here are the safety rules you need to remember when ever your using the Internet:

1. **DO NOT-** give any one your personal information, such as your name or you parents names, your address or the name of the school you go to.
2. **DO NOT-** speak to strangers online.
3. **DO NOT-** meet up or agree to meet up with anyone you have met online.
4. **DO NOT-** fill out any profile or forms online asking you for your name and address.
5. **DO NOT-** use chat groups with out an adults permission
6. **DO NOT-** stay online and continue to look at something your parents would not like.
7. **DO NOT-** post any pictures or images of your self online without your parents permission.
8. **DO NOT-** install or download anything from the internet without an adults permission.
9. **Speak to your parents-** if you have any questions about what you have seen on the internet.
10. **Remember-** if you are talking to someone online, and they make you feel uncomfortable, you **DO NOT** have to talk back to them.
