

How many crimes in general have been committed against females in your area each year for the past 10 years?

Of the 46 police forces this question was posed to under freedom of information 13 either refused to answer citing that the request would take longer than 18 hours or they did not respond.

This FOI request was posed in November 2021, this report is being written in February 2022 leaving more than enough time for the police forces to respond during the Covid epidemic.

General crime relates to any and all crimes reported by a female each year within a ten-year period.

2011 = 876386 crimes in total.

2012 = 913952 crimes in total

2013 = 912608 crimes in total

2014 = 958650 crimes in total

2015 = 1062586 crimes in total

2016 = 1210728 crimes in total

2017 = 1378697 crimes in total

2018 = 1501251 crimes in total

2019 = 1617525 crimes in total

2020 = 1568972 crimes in total

2021 (supplied data) = 1430704 crimes in total.

If we break this down by year the results are easier to understand.

2011.

1st If we divide 876386 by the 33 police forces that responded we can average a total of approximately 26,557 general crimes against females per police force.

2nd Using the original total of 876386 divided by 52 we get an average of 16,854 crimes per week.

3rd If we then divide the per police force average, 26,557 by 52 it becomes 511 crimes per week, per area. Or 73 crimes per day per area.

2012.

1st If we divide 913952 by the 33 police forces that responded we can average a total of approximately 27,696 general crimes against females per police force.

2nd Using the original total of 913952 divided by 52 we get an average of 17,576 crimes per week.

3rd If we then divide the per police force average, 27,696 by 52 it becomes 533 crimes per week, per area. Or 76 crimes per day per area. An increase of 3 crimes per day, per area.

2013.

1st If we divide 912608 by the 33 police forces that responded we can average a total of approximately 27,655 general crimes against females per police force.

2nd Using the original total of 912608 divided by 52 we get an average of 17,550 crimes per week.

3rd If we then divide the per police force average, 27,655 by 52 it becomes 532 crimes per week, per area. Or 76 crimes per day per area.

2014

1st If we divide 958650 by the 33 police forces that responded we can average a total of approximately 29,050 general crimes against females per police force.

2nd Using the original total of 958650 divided by 52 we get an average of 18,436 crimes per week.

3rd If we then divide the per police force average, 29,050 by 52 it becomes 559 crimes per week, per area. Or 80 crimes per day per area. An increase of 4 crimes per day per area.

2015

1st If we divide 1062586 by the 33 police forces that responded we can average a total of approximately 32,200 general crimes against females per police force.

2nd Using the original total of 1062586 divided by 52 we get an average of 20,434 crimes per week.

3rd If we then divide the per police force average, 32,200 by 52 it becomes 619 crimes per week, per area. Or 88 crimes per day per area. An increase of 8 crimes per day per police force.

2016

1st If we divide 1210728 by the 33 police forces that responded we can average a total of approximately 36,689 general crimes against females per police force.

2nd Using the original total of 1210728 divided by 52 we get an average of 23,283 crimes per week.

3rd If we then divide the per police force average, 36,689 by 52 it becomes 706 crimes per week, per area. Or 101 crimes per day per area. An increase of 13 crimes per day, per police force.

2017

1st If we divide 1378697 by the 33 police forces that responded we can average a total of approximately 41,779 general crimes against females per police force.

2nd Using the original total of 1378697 divided by 52 we get an average of 26,513 crimes per week.

3rd If we then divide the per police force average, 41,779 by 52 it becomes 803 crimes per week, per area. Or 115 crimes per day per area. An increase of 14 crimes per day per police force.

2018

1st If we divide 1501251 by the 33 police forces that responded we can average a total of approximately 45,492 general crimes against females per police force.

2nd Using the original total of 1501251 divided by 52 we get an average of 28,870 crimes per week.

3rd If we then divide the per police force average, 45,492 by 52 it becomes 875 crimes per week, per area. Or 125 crimes per day per area. An increase of 10 crimes per day per police force.

2019

1st If we divide 1617525 by the 33 police forces that responded we can average a total of approximately 49,016 general crimes against females per police force.

2nd Using the original total of 1617525 divided by 52 we get an average of 31,106 crimes per week.

3rd If we then divide the per police force average, 49,016 by 52 it becomes 943 crimes per week, per area. Or 135 crimes per day per area. An increase of 10 crimes per day per police force.

2020

1st If we divide 1568972 by the 33 police forces that responded we can average a total of approximately 47,545 general crimes against females per police force.

2nd Using the original total of 1568972 divided by 52 we get an average of 30,173 crimes per week.

3rd If we then divide the per police force average, 47,545 by 52 it becomes 914 crimes per week, per area. Or 131 crimes per day per area. A decrease of 4 crimes per day per police force.

2021

1st If we divide 1430704 by the 33 police forces that responded we can average a total of approximately 43,355 general crimes against females per police force.

2nd Using the original total of 1430704 divided by 52 we get an average of 27,514 crimes per week.

3rd If we then divide the per police force average, 43,355 by 52 it becomes 833 crimes per week, per area. Or 119 crimes per day per area. A decrease of 12 crimes per day per police force.

It should be noted that not all crimes reported include a gender, as such these numbers are the lowest estimates of crimes where a female is a victim. These statistics also do not include missing, drug related, driving offenses etc.
